DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On June 18, 2002, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Harbor Communications LLC (Harbor) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-389. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Harbor failed to file an annual report for the year 2005 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). On June 6, 2006, the Commission notified Harbor that the report had not been received. At the July 27, 2006, public meeting, the Commission determined that Harbor's certificate of authority should be canceled. Harbor's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 06-493.

On September 7, 2006, Harbor filed a request to suspend Order No. 06-493, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Harbor filed the requested information.

The information sent by Harbor to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Harbor is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Harbor's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 06-493 canceling the certificate of authority of Harbor Communications LLC, is rescinded.
