DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On October 14, 2005, Cascade Communication Technology Co (“CCT”) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 05-1110.

In a letter dated January 30, 2007, Steven Wang, Chief Executive Officer of CCT, informed the Commission that its certificate of authority should be withdrawn. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2007, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Cascade Communication Technology Co. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Cascade Communication Technology Co. is cancelled.
