## DISPOSITION: COMPLIANCE FILING APPROVED

Earlier in this investigation, we directed Portland General Electric Company (PGE) and other utilities to file revised tariffs and standard contract forms that set forth rates, terms and conditions for Qualifying Facilities (QFs). *See* Order No. 06-538. Pursuant to that order, PGE filed a revised Schedule 201 and two standard contract forms; one for QFs within its service territory and one for off-system QFs. To allow our Staff sufficient time to review the filings, we suspended them for investigation at the November 7, 2006, Commission Public Meeting.

During its review, Staff, with assistance from the Department of Energy and a small QF owner, identified a limited number of changes to the filings required for full compliance with our order. On January 23, 2007, PGE made a supplemental filing to incorporate Staff's requested changes.

On February 1, 2007, Staff reported its finding that PGE's supplemental filing complies with Order No. 06-538. Staff served a copy of its finding to all parties to this docket. None have objected to Staff's finding or opposed allowing PGE's filing to go into effect.

Based on Staff's finding, we conclude that PGE's supplemental Advice No. 06-26 should be approved and allowed to go into effect. In making this decision, we note that PGE requested a May 20, 2007, effective date for its supplemental filing. With this approval, PGE may seek an earlier effective date by filing new tariff sheets and standard contracts consistent with this filing.

## **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that supplemental Advice No. 06-26, filed by Portland General Electric Company on January 23, 2007, is approved and allowed to go into effect.
