**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED**

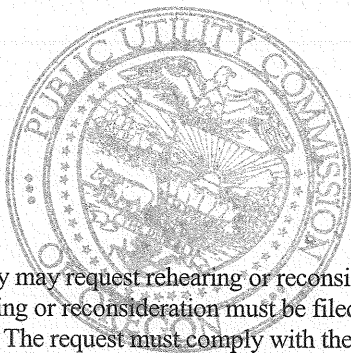
On November 2, 2001, Regal Diversified Inc. d/b/a Regal Telephone Company (Regal) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 01-932.

In a letter dated April 9, 2007, Kenneth Brown, President of Regal Diversified Inc. d/b/a Regal Telephone Company, informed the Commission that Regal has no customers in Oregon and requested their certificate of authority be canceled. The company is reminded that because they had a certificate of authority for one or more days in Oregon during 2007, it is required to file an Annual Fee Statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Regal Diversified Inc. d/b/a Regal Telephone Company should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Regal Diversified Inc. d/b/a Regal Telephone Company is cancelled.
