ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On May 4, 1998, Marathon Communications Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 98-186. The company later changed its name to WTI LLC

In a letter dated March 19, 2007, Marcos Melendez, President of WTI LLC, requested that the certificate of authority for WTI LLC be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2007, it is required to file an annual revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by WTI LLC should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by WTI LLC is cancelled.
