**DISPOSITION: RATE SCHEDULES SUSPENDED
 FOR ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF TIME**


On October 31, 2006, Agate Water Company filed revised rate schedules in Advice No. 06-27 to be effective on December 1, 2006. At its November 21, 2006, public meeting, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) found good and sufficient cause exists to investigate the propriety and reasonableness of the rates pursuant to ORS 757.210 and 757.215 and suspended the filing pending an investigation. On November 24, 2006, the Commission issued Order No. 06-647, suspending Advice No. 06-27 for a six-month period of time.

The Commission has concluded that it will not have an opportunity to complete its investigation in this case prior to the expiration of the initial suspension period, scheduled to end on June 1, 2007. Accordingly, the suspension should be extended for an additional period not exceeding three months, pursuant to ORS 757.215(1).


ORDER
