DISPOSITION: REAUTHORIZATION FOR DEFERRAL APPROVED

On June 7, 2007, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) requested reauthorization to defer costs related to Intervenor Funding Grants for later incorporation in rates. Current authorization for deferral extends through June 30, 2007, pursuant to Order No. 06-412.

On July 2, 2003, the Commission issued Order No. 03-388, which approved the Intervenor Funding Agreement among PacifiCorp, PGE, Northwest Natural Gas Company, Northwest Industrial Gas Users, Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon and Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, pursuant to ORS 757.072. A description of the Intervenor Funding Agreement is contained in the Staff Report, attached as Appendix A, and incorporated by reference.

At its Public Meeting on July 24, 2007, the Commission adopted Staff's Recommendation and approved PGE's request for reauthorization for deferred costs related to Intervenor Funding Grants.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1) Portland General Electric's request for reauthorization to defer costs related to Intervenor Funding Grants until June 30, 2008, is approved.
- 2) Portland General Electric is directed to account for the grants by customer class.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Commission approve Portland General Electric's request to defer costs related to Intervenor Funding Grants beginning July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

DISCUSSION:

On June 7, 2007, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a request for reauthorization to defer Intervenor Funding Costs. Current authorization for this deferral extends through June 30, 2007, pursuant to Order No. 06-412.

On July 2, 2003, the Commission issued Order No. 03-388, which, among other things, approved the Intervenor Funding Agreement among PacifiCorp, PGE, Northwest Natural Gas Company, Northwest Industrial Gas Users, Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB), and Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, dated February 5, 2003 (the Intervenor Funding Agreement). Pursuant to 757.072(2) "...any agreement entered into... must be approved by the Commission before any financial assistance is provided..." and (3) "...in administering an agreement...the Commission by rule or by order may determine...(c) the manner in which the financial assistance will be recovered in rates."

The Intervenor Funding Agreement in Order No. 03-388 sets forth the amounts to be contributed by each utility, the procedures for budget submittals by Intervenor, and the payment of grants by each utility. The agreement authorizes the utility to account for the grants in three separate funds:

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- 1) CUB Fund;
- 2) Preauthorized Matching Fund; and
- 3) Issue Fund.

The Intervenor Funding Agreement required the costs of each fund be allocated to the appropriate customer class. CUB funds are generated from residential rates and industrial customers fund the amounts for the Preauthorized Matching Fund (Matching Fund). The Commission allocates requested amounts from the Issue Fund to align the costs of advocacy with the intended beneficiaries of the advocacy.

Pursuant to Order 03-388, the maximum rollover amount for the Preauthorized Matching Fund is \$50,000. Amounts will be debited to the deferral account only as funds are actually dispersed.

In its June 7, 2007, filing, PGE reports the following balances and accruals in its intervenor funding accounts:

Proposed Accounting

The proposed deferrals would be recorded in separate subaccounts of FERC account 182.3 (Miscellaneous Deferred Debits). In the absence of deferral approval, the company would record the amounts in the subaccounts of FERC account 930 (Miscellaneous General Expenses).

¹ Approximate balance does not consider interest accruals and exact payout dates.
