DISPOSITION: WAIVER GRANTED

On July 25, 2007, Cascade Natural Gas (Cascade or Company) requested a waiver, pursuant to Order No. 07-002, to extend the filing deadline for the upcoming Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) from August 9, 2007, to December 15, 2008. Cascade seeks the extension in order to correspond with the timing of the Company's next IRP filing deadline in the State of Washington.

According to guideline 3(a) of Order No. 07-002, "...If the utility does not intend to take any significant resource action for at least two years after its next IRP is due, the utility may request an extension of its filing date from the Commission." As indicated in the Company's 2004 IRP, Cascade does not anticipate requiring incremental pipeline capacity resources to support its Oregon Operations until the 2012/2013 time period.

In further support of its request to waive the two-year filing deadline, Cascade states that it will provide, no later than August 9, 2007, an informational filing that will meet the requirements of an Annual Update of its last acknowledged plan. In compliance with guideline 3(g) of Order No. 07-002, the update will describe Cascade's progress on implementing its two-year action plan, provide an assessment of what has changed since the acknowledgement of the last plan, and justify any deviations from the acknowledged action plan.

No party opposes Cascade's request.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Cascade Natural Gas' request for a waiver of Order No. 07-002 is granted. The filing deadline for the Integrated Resource Plan is extended to December 15, 2008.
