DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On March 23, 2004, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Lightyear Network Solutions LLC (Lightyear) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-166. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Lightyear failed to file an annual report for the year 2006 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). On May 2, June 11, and June 27, 2007, the Commission notified Lightyear that the report had not been received. At the July 7, 2007, public meeting, the Commission determined that Lightyear's certificate of authority should be canceled. Lightyear's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 07-307.

On July 25, 2007, Lightyear filed a request to suspend Order No. 07-307, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Lightyear filed the requested information.

The information sent by Lightyear to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Lightyear is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Lightyear's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 07-307 canceling the certificate of authority of Lightyear Network Solutions LLC, is rescinded.
