ORDER

**DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED**

On December 16, 1997, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Global Crossing Telemanagement Inc. (Global Crossing Tel) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 97-488. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Global Crossing Tel failed to comply with Oregon Universal Service Fund requirements per ORS 759.425. At the October 9, 2007, public meeting, the Commission determined that Global Crossing Tel's certificate of authority should be canceled. Global Crossing Tel's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 07-458.


On November 7, 2007, Global Crossing Tel filed a request to suspend Order No. 07-458, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Global Crossing Tel filed the requested information.

The information sent by Global Crossing Tel to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Global Crossing Tel is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Global Crossing Tel's certificate should be rescinded.


**ORDER**


IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 07-458 canceling the certificate of authority of Global Crossing Telemanagement Inc. is rescinded.
