DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

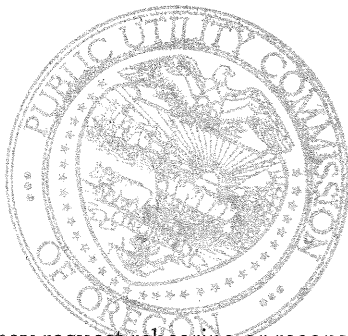
On September 7, 2004, OnFiber Communications Inc. ("OnFiber") was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-506.

In a letter dated December 4, 2007, the Commission was informed that due to an internal restructuring between Qwest Communications Corporation and OnFiber Communications Inc., the final result is the cancellation of the certificate of authority for OnFiber. OnFiber is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon during 2007, it is required to file an annual fee statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by OnFiber Communications Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by OnFiber Communications Inc. is cancelled.
