**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED**

On August 31, 1998, Com-Tech Resources Inc. (Com-Tech) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 98-361.

In a letter dated April 24, 2008, Ralph Tipple, President of Com-Tech Resources, informed the Commission that Com-Tech is no longer doing business in Oregon and its certificate of authority should be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2008, it is required to file a revenue fee statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Com-Tech Resources Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Com-Tech Resources Inc. is cancelled.
