DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On November 30, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Tel West Communications LLC (Tel West) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-1009. After investigation, the Commission found that Tel West failed to submit the 2007 annual fee statement and payment by the due date of April 1, 2008. *See* OAR 860-032-0095. On April 14, 2008, the Commission notified the certificate holder that the required statement and fees were not received. In view of the foregoing, the Commission determined at its May 6, 2008, Public Meeting that the certificate holder had failed to comply with Commission rules and terms of the certificate. The certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service for Tel West was cancelled, per OAR 860-032-0008(2). *See* Order No. 08-281.


On July 10, 2008, Tel West filed a request to suspend Order No. 08-281, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Tel West paid the requested fees.

The statement and fees submitted by Tel West to the Commission were late. However, they have now been received and indicate Tel West is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Tel West's certificate should be rescinded.


ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 08-281 canceling the certificate of authority of Tel West Communications LLC, is rescinded.


