DISPOSITION: SUPPLEMENT TO ORDER NO. 08-033

In Order No. 08-033, issued on January 23, 2008, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) assessed charges against PHONE SOLUTION INC. That order stated that PHONE SOLUTION INC. failed to submit the quarterly payment(s) by the due date(s) as set out in OAR 860-032-0620(3).

That order contained an incorrect contribution amount owed which in turn resulted in an incorrect interest amount. This order corrects both amounts.

Therefore, pursuant to OAR 860-032-0097, the Commission staff has proposed the following corrected assessment amount of \$3,051.46, which can include any or all of the following: contribution payments(s), late payment penalty(ies), interest and late statement fee(s), including any portion due but not paid for period(s). The corrected fees are for the fourth quarter of 2003 and the first quarter of 2004.

Where applicable, the interest amount is calculated as of the date of this order. The interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment. *See* OAR 860-032-0620(7). Conclusions

PHONE SOLUTION INC. failed to meet its filing obligations required by law. The amount set forth above should be assessed, with the exception that any applicable interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The above amounts are assessed against PHONE SOLUTION INC. and are immediately due and payable to the Public Utility Commission, PO Box 2153, Salem, Oregon 97308-2153.
- 2. Where applicable, interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.
