DISPOSITION: DOCKET CLOSED WITH PREJUDICE

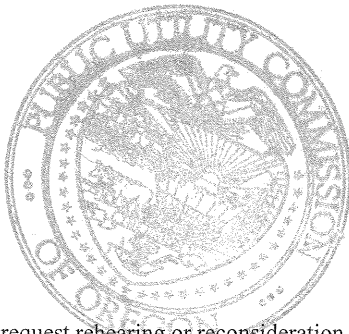
On May 23, 2008, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a petition for arbitration under 47 U.S.C. §252(b) seeking an interconnection agreement with Hunter Construction, Inc., dba Hunter Communications and Core Digital Services (Hunter). In the filing, Qwest sought approval of the TRO/TRRO Amendment attached to its petition.


Hunter failed to respond to the petition. Following a telephone call and letter to Hunter, Qwest's request was processed under docket ARB 497(5) and approved as a negotiated amendment to the parties' interconnection agreement. See Order No. 08-440. Accordingly, there is no further need for this docket.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that this docket is closed with prejudice.
