#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

I recommend that the Commission suspend Portland General Electric's application for revised tariff schedules in Advice No. 08-15.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

On October 24, 2008, Portland General Electric (PGE) filed Advice No. 08-15, an application for revised tariff schedules. The filing has been docketed as UE 204. The tariffs would implement a rate revision, increasing PGE's revenues by \$12.9 million, or 0.8 percent overall.

The purpose of this filing is to recover costs associated with PGE's Selective Water Withdrawal Project (SWW Project). The SWW Project is designed to enhance fish passage on the Deschutes River. The SWW Project is expected to be operational on or before May 1, 2009.

The company states that this filing is being made in response to an agreement reached in UE 197. PGE, with the support of signing parties, agreed to remove the revenue requirements of the SWW Project from that docket and to file a separate request focused only on the SWW Project.

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Staff recommends the Commission suspend the tariffs for investigation. Suspending the tariffs will allow the Commission to evaluate the reasonableness of the company's proposed rates.

## PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:

PGE's application for revised tariff schedules in Advice No. 08-15 (UE 204), with a proposed effective date of November 24, 2008, be suspended for six months.
