DISPOSITION: PETITION WITHDRAWN; DOCKET CLOSED

On July 14, 2006, Oregon Trail Electric Consumers Cooperative, Inc. (Oregon Trail) filed a petition seeking remedies for identified pole attachment violations. The petition arose out of a dispute between Oregon Trail and Almega Cable (Almega) regarding pole attachment and rental fees for poles owned by Oregon Trail.

On December 1, 2006, Oregon Trail filed a motion seeking to stay this proceeding to allow the parties an opportunity to resolve the dispute informally. Settlement discussions resulted in a Letter Agreement, which required Almega to pay certain amounts for monthly payments, back rent, and sanctions, and to take actions to remedy certain violations.

On February 2, 2009, Oregon Trail notified the Commission that the parties have come to a settlement of all issues raised in the petition, and that Alemga has remedied all of the pole attachment violations and settlement of its financial obligations to Oregon Trail. Accordingly, Oregon Trail requests that this docket be closed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Remedy of Pole Attachment Violations, filed by Oregon Trail Electric Consumers Cooperative, Inc., docketed as UM 1272, is closed.
