DISPOSITION: MOTION TO DISMISS GRANTED

On March 13, 2009, Fish Mill Lodges Water System (Fish Mill or the Company) filed a motion to withdraw its petition for the adoption of an agreement/contract that would prescribe the terms and conditions of its service to its customers. The Company filed its motion after a prehearing conference at which the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) and several customers appeared in opposition to the petition.

In its motion Fish Mill states that it has conferred with Staff and there is no opposition to the motion to dismiss.


By letter dated March 17, 2009, Jason Jones, attorney for Staff, states that Staff and the Company had discussions regarding the proposed agreement that culminated in the filing of Fish Mill's motion.


As the petitioner, Fish Mill has the right to withdraw its petition except in the case of extraordinary circumstances in the interest of justice. No other party having appeared in support of the petition, the time to reply to the motion is waived and the motion is granted.

ORDER

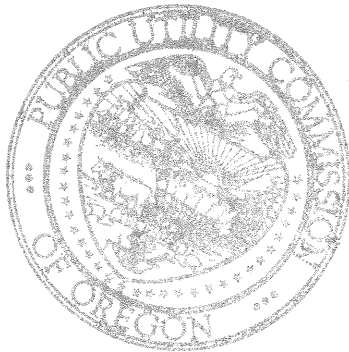
IT IS ORDERED that Fish Mill Lodges Water System's petition for adoption of the proposed agreement/contract between the Company and its customers is dismissed.
