ORDER

DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED

On March 11, 2009, Northwest Running Boards of Clackamas (Complainant) filed a complaint against Rio Communications and Integra Telecom of Oregon (Defendants). The complaint concerned the transfer of a telephone number between two businesses. On March 26 and 27, 2009, Defendants filed separate answers to the complaint. With its answer, Integra also filed a motion to dismiss.

On April 3, 2009, Complainant reported that it has settled this dispute with Defendants and requested to withdraw its complaint.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED THAT the complaint filed by Northwest Running Boards of Clackamas against Rio Communications and Integra Telecom of Oregon, is dismissed.
