DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On November 21, 2008, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Reliance Communications International Inc. (Reliance) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 08-551. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Reliance failed to file an annual report for the year 2008 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). On April 13, 2009, and May 11, 2009, the Commission notified Reliance that the report had not been received. At the June 16, 2009, public meeting, the Commission determined that Reliance's certificate of authority should be canceled. Reliance's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 09-239.


On July 17, 2009, Reliance filed a request to suspend Order No. 09-239, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Reliance filed the requested information.

The information sent by Reliance to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Reliance is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Reliance's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 09-239 canceling the certificate of authority of Reliance Communications International Inc., is rescinded.
