ORDER

**DISPOSITION: APPLICATION WITHDRAWN; DOCKET CLOSED**

On September 3, 2009, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power), filed an application for accounting order regarding coal stripping costs with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission). The Commission docketed the filing as UM 1448.

At the time of the application, Pacific Power was attempting to address net power cost issues associated with the Transition Adjustment Mechanism proceeding (docket UE 207). Since that time the parties in UE 207 have reached an all-party settlement which includes commitment by Pacific Power to request to withdraw this application without prejudice and an agreement by the other parties (Commission Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and Sempra Energy Solutions LLC) not to object to the withdrawal.

On September 25, 2009, Pacific Power notified the Commission that it is withdrawing its filing and requests that docket UM 1448 be closed.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Docket UM 1448 is closed.
