In a letter dated October 21, 2009, Monique Bynres, Consultant for AGM, requested the Commission cancel its certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2009, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by AGM Telecom Corporation should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by AGM Telecom Corporation is cancelled.
