ORDER

Application for Reauthorization of Deferral of Investigation and Remediation Response Costs Associated with the Portland Harbor and Harbor Oil Superfund Sites Cleanup and Restoration.

DISPOSITION: APPLICATION WITHDRAWN; DOCKET CLOSED

On March 31, 2008, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed an Application for Deferral of Investigation and Remediation Response Costs Associated with the Portland Harbor and Harbor Oil Superfund Sites Cleanup and Restoration (Original Application). In Order No. 09-052, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) approved the Original Application on February 6, 2009.

On March 30, 2009, PGE filed an Application for Reauthorization to Defer Investigation and Remediation Response Costs Associated with the Portland Harbor and Harbor Oil Superfund Sites Cleanup and Restoration (Reauthorization Application). PGE requested that reauthorization of the deferral commence effective March 31, 2009, the date of expiration for the original deferral. On July 20, 2009, a prehearing conference was held, and a procedural schedule was established to address the Reauthorization Application, with a hearing scheduled to be held on January 14, 2010.

Prior to the scheduled hearing, PGE met with Commission Staff and the two intervenors in the proceeding, Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities. On January 6, 2010, PGE filed a letter with the Commission explaining that PGE had proposed, at the meeting, to withdraw the Reauthorization Application and to not seek amortization of the amounts deferred under the Original Application. PGE indicated that there was no opposition to this proposal. As a result, PGE requests closure of the docket.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Docket UM 1373 is closed.
