DISPOSITION:

REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On August 12, 2009, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) entered Order No. 09-313, asserting jurisdiction over the Government Camp Water Company (the Company). The Commission also directed the Company to file the appropriate tariffs within 60 days of the date of the order, or no later than October 12, 2009.

The Commission previously granted four extensions to the Company to submit its rate case application and supporting documentation.

On February 12, 2010, the Company filed a letter requesting an additional 30-day extension of time from February 12, 2010, to March 15, 2010, to submit its rate case application and supporting documentation. The Company stated that after its December 30, 2009, meeting with Commission Staff (Staff) it realized that the testing period was a year old and some significant changes have taken place. Specifically, the Company stated that its bookkeeper informed it that the 2009 accounting would be completed this week, and that the Company will then be able to change its application for the test period of 2009.

## **ORDER**

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The request of Government Camp Water Company for an additional extension of time to file its rate case application, supporting documentation, and tariffs is granted.
- 2. The filing due date for the rate case application, supporting documentation, and tariffs is March 15, 2010.
