ORDER

DISPOSITION: REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On February 23, 2010, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) entered Order No. 10-029, asserting jurisdiction over the Pelican Bay Heights Water System (the Company). The Commission also directed the Company to file the appropriate tariffs within 60 days of the date of the order, or no later than April 4, 2010. Since April 4, 2010 falls on a Sunday, the filing is due on the next business day, which is April 5, 2010.

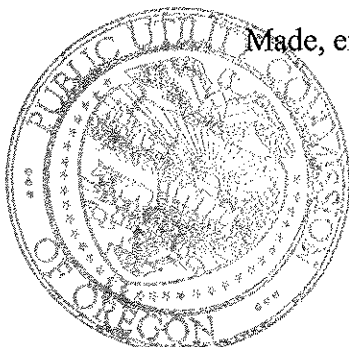
A legal representative for the Company electronically filed a letter on April 2, 2010, requesting an extension of time to file the tariffs in order have more time to work with their attorney in an effort to turn over the operation of the water system to the Homeowners Association. The Company seeks a 90-day extension of time, from April 5, 2010, to July 4, 2010, to submit its rate case application and supporting documentation. Since July 4 falls on a Sunday, and this legal holiday is observed on Monday, July 5, the filing date would be on the next business day, which is Tuesday, July 6, 2010.


ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The request of Pelican Bay Heights Water System for an extension of time to file its rate case application, supporting documentation, and tariffs is granted.
2. The filing due date for the rate case application, supporting documentation, and tariffs is July 6, 2010.
