**DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED  
IN PART**

On February 23, 2004, Working Assets Funding Service Inc. (WASF) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 04-098.

In a letter dated March 25, 2010, Jean Parker, Legal Director for WASF, requested that the certificate of authority for WASF be amended to reflect that WASF will only be a provider of interexchange toll telecommunications service. WASF will no longer provide switched local dial tone telecommunications service. WASF stated that the company is no longer providing resold local exchange service in Oregon.

In view of the foregoing, WASF's authority to provide intraexchange switched (local dial tone) telecommunications service within all exchanges of the telecommunications utilities listed in Appendix A to Order No.04-098 should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority held by Working Assets Funding Service Inc. to provide intraexchange switched (local dial tone) telecommunications service is canceled. The authority to provide interexchange switched (toll) telecommunications service remains in effect.
