ORDER

An Investigation Pursuant to ORS 756.515 to Determine Jurisdiction.

DISPOSITION: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On August 12, 2009, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) entered Order No. 09-313, asserting jurisdiction over the Government Camp Water Company (the Company). The Commission also directed the Company to file the appropriate tariffs within 60 days of the date of the order, or no later than October 12, 2009.

The Commission previously granted seven extensions to the Company to submit its rate case application and supporting documentation. The Company should note that this is the last extension that will be granted.

On May 11, 2010, the Company filed a letter requesting an additional 30-day extension of time from May 14, 2010, to June 13, 2010, to submit its rate case application and supporting documentation. The Company stated its accountant is trying to complete the application with the information from the 2009 books, but is taking longer than planned. Since June 13 falls on a Sunday, the filing date is on the next business day, which is Monday, June 14, 2010.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The request of Government Camp Water Company for an additional extension of time to file its rate case application, supporting documentation, and tariffs is granted.

2. The filing due date for the rate case application, supporting documentation, and tariffs is June 14, 2010.
