ORDER

An Investigation Pursuant to ORS 756.515 to Determine Jurisdiction.

DISPOSITION: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On August 12, 2009, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) entered Order No. 09-313, asserting jurisdiction over the Government Camp Water Company (the Company). The Commission also directed the Company to file the appropriate tariffs within 60 days of the date of the order, or no later than October 12, 2009.

The Company has experienced difficulties in submitting tariffs, and has been granted eight extensions to submit its rate case application and supporting documentation. In granting the last request, the Commission noted that no additional requests for extensions would be considered.

Despite that mandate, the Company seeks an additional 30-day extension of time from June 14, 2010, to July 14, 2010, to submit its rate case application and supporting documentation. The Company stated that it has been unable to reach its accountant.

Under these circumstances, the Commission is willing to modify its earlier decision and allow this one last extension. To be clear, however, this is the last extension that will be granted. The Company must file its rate case application and supporting testimony no later than July 14, 2010, or be subject to charges of failing to comply with a Commission order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The request of Government Camp Water Company for an additional extension of time to file its rate case application, supporting documentation, and tariffs is granted.
- 2. Government Camp Water Company must file its rate case application, supporting documentation, and tariffs on or before July 14, 2010.
