DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED  
IN PART

On March 23, 2004, SBC Long Distance LLC (SBC LD) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 04-168.


In a letter dated June 25, 2010, David Collier, Area Manager, Regulatory, AT&T, requested that the certificate of authority for SBC Long Distance LLC be amended to reflect that SBC LD will only be a provider of interexchange toll statewide in Oregon. The letter noted that SBC LD is ceasing the provision of all services related to its non-interexchange operations and that there are no longer any customers receiving such services.

In view of the foregoing, SBC LD's authority to provide intraexchange switched service (local dial tone) and intraexchange non-switched private line (dedicated transmission) telecommunications service within all exchanges of the telecommunications utilities listed in Appendix A to Order No. 04-168 should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority held by SBC Long Distance LLC to provide intraexchange switched (local dial tone) and intraexchange non-switched (dedicated transmission service) is canceled.
