DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On April 27, 2006, Comtel Telcom Assets LP (Comtel) was granted certificates of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 06-210.

In a letter dated August 4, 2010, Leslie Ellis, Manager, Regulatory Affairs, requested the Commission cancel its certificates of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon. Effective July 31, 2010, Comtel entered into an asset purchase agreement with Matrix Telecom, Inc. (Matrix) to sell substantially all of its assets, including customers, to Matrix. Matrix holds a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon. *See* Order No. 05-599, Docket CP 1281. Comtel is reminded that because it had these certificates of authority for one or more days during 2010, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year for each entity.

In view of the foregoing, the certificates of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Comtel Telcom Assets LP should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of authority held by Comtel Telcom Assets LP are cancelled.
