DISPOSITION: REQUEST APPROVED

On May 3, 2011, Portland General Electric Company (PGE), filed a request with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission), asking that the Commission require it to sign the Revised Residential Exchange Program Settlement Agreement and, on May 6, 2011, PGE supplemented its filing asking the Commission to direct PGE to sign the Residential Exchange Program Settlement Implementation Agreement offered by the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA). PGE seeks authorization to execute the Settlement Agreements. PGE concludes that the risks of signing the agreement are outweighed by its benefits.

Staff's recommendation and further description of the procedural history of the Settlement Agreement is contained in the Staff Report, attached as Appendix A and incorporated by reference.

At its Public Meeting on May 17, 2011, the Commission adopted Staff's recommendation that the Commission issue an order directing PGE to execute the revised settlement agreement and the implementation agreement.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Portland General Electric Company shall execute the proposed Bonneville Power Administration Residential Exchange Program Settlement Agreement.
- 2. Portland General Electric Company shall execute the proposed Bonneville Power Administration Residential Exchange Program Settlement Implementation Agreement.


I recommend that the Commission require Portland General Electric (PGE) to execute the proposed revised Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) Residential Exchange Program Settlement Agreement and the Residential Exchange Program Settlement Implementation Agreement.

DISCUSSION:

For a discussion of the background and issues, please refer to the staff discussion contained in April 5, 2011, public meeting agenda item #1, "Execution of long-term settlement agreement resolving Residential Exchange Program issues," as well as the May 17, 2011, public meeting regular agenda item titled, "Execution of revised long-term settlement agreement resolving Residential Exchange Program issues."

I agree with PGE's assessment outlined in its filing and supplemental correspondence, the latter dated May 6, 2011. As such, I support PGE's request to be directed to execute the Revised Residential Exchange Program Settlement Agreement and the Residential Exchange Program Settlement Implementation Agreement.

In addition, I should note that PGE's current Residential Exchange Program (REP) contract with BPA expires on September 30, 2011. In the event the revised Settlement Agreement does not become effective, either by the failure of the publicly-owned utilities to produce a sufficient number of signers, or because it is not approved by BPA, then PGE will need to negotiate with BPA (and OPUC Staff) an alternative REP mechanism,

obtain Commission approval to execute the alternative agreement, and execute it prior to October 1, 2011.
