Proposed Tariff for Electric Service,
Advice No. 10-20.

DISPOSITION: TARIFF SHEETS FURTHER SUSPENDED

In Order No. 11-012,¹ the Public Utility Commission of Oregon found good and sufficient cause existed to investigate Advice No. 10-20 filed by Portland General Electric Company on October 22, 2010. The Commission therefore suspended Advice No. 10-20 for a period of time not to exceed three months from January 1, 2011. Finding additional time was required to complete the investigation, the Commission further suspended the tariff sheets in Order No. 11-087. The second suspension will expire June 30, 2011.

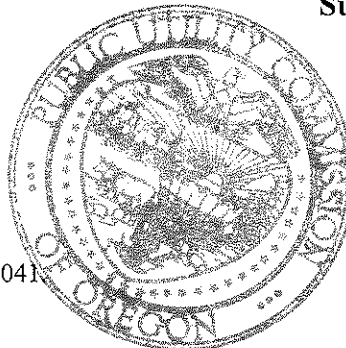
ORS 757.215(1) authorizes the Commission to suspend a rate filing for a period not to exceed nine months. We conclude at this time that a full nine-month suspension is necessary to investigate Advice No. 10-20. We therefore suspend Advice No. 10-20 for an additional three months.

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 10-20 filed by Portland General Electric Company is suspended until September 30, 2011.
