DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On September 24, 2008, Global Capacity Group, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 08-482.

In a letter dated July 12, 2011, Lance Steinhart, Attorney for Global Capacity Group, Inc., requested the Commission cancel its certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2011, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Global Capacity Group, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Global Capacity Group, Inc. is canceled.
