ORDER


DISPOSITION: TARIFF SHEETS FURTHER SUSPENDED

In Order No. 11-012,¹ the Public Utility Commission of Oregon found good and sufficient cause existed to investigate Advice No. 10-20 filed by Portland General Electric Company (PGE) on October 22, 2010. The Commission therefore suspended Advice No. 10-20 for a period of time not to exceed three months from January 1, 2011. Finding additional time was required to complete the investigation, the Commission further suspended the tariff sheets in Order Nos. 11-087 and 11-197. The current suspension period will expire September 30, 2011.


On September 22, 2011, PGE filed a letter agreeing to extend the suspension period until December 31, 2011, to allow further proceedings in this docket. Under our authority in ORS 757.215(2), we suspend Advice No. 10-20 for an additional three months.

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 10-20 filed by Portland General Electric Company is suspended until December 31, 2011.

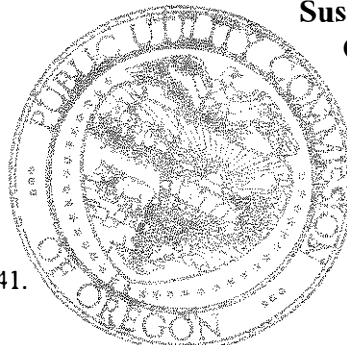
