DISPOSITION:

COMPLAINT DISMISSED

In this order, we grant the motion of the City of Lincoln City, Lincoln County, and Tillamook County to dismiss their complaint against CenturyLink, Inc. and its subsidiary, United Telephone Company of the Northwest, d/b/a CenturyLink.

I. DISCUSSION

On June 5, 2011, the City of Lincoln City, Lincoln County, and Tillamook County filed a complaint against CenturyLink, alleging reliability problems in the CenturyLink network's fiber-optic cable between Sheridan and Salem, Oregon, and sought to have CenturyLink modify its network to alleviate the alleged deficiencies.

On February 8, 2013, complainants filed a motion to dismiss. The complainants state in their motion that CenturyLink conducted a test of completed modifications to the facilities with the alleged deficiencies on September 13, 2012, and that complainants' engineers observed the test and were satisfied that the requested modifications were functioning properly. Complainants assert that the concerns forming the basis of their complaint have been fully addressed and seek dismissal of the complaint.

We find that the reliability issues giving rise to the complaint have been addressed to the satisfaction of the parties and, accordingly, we conclude that the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

II. ORDER

IT IS ORDERED, that the complaint filed by the City of Lincoln City, Lincoln County, and Tillamook County against CenturyLink, Inc., and United Telephone Company of the Northwest, d/b/a CenturyLink, is dismissed with prejudice. This docket is closed.
