ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On March 27, 2008, Digizip.com, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 08-187.

In a letter dated April 1, 2012, Leon Nowalsky, Attorney for Wholesale Carrier Services, Inc. ("WCS") and Digizip.com, Inc. ("Digizip"), informed the Commission of an Asset Purchase Agreement whereby WCS will acquire all of the assets of Digizip including Digizip's customer accounts in Oregon. Digizip requested relinquishment of their certificate of authority pursuant to this notification.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Digizip.com, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Digizip.com, Inc. is canceled.
