
## DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On May 3, 2007, 360networks(USA), Inc. ("360networks") was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 07-174.

In a letter dated April 4, 2013, Brett Ferenchak, Counsel to 360networks, requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon. The company merged with and into Zayo Group LLC ("Zayo") with Zayo being the surviving entity and, as a result, 360networks no longer exists as a separate corporate entity.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by 360networks(USA), Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by 360networks(USA), Inc. is canceled.



A party may reaces rehearing or reconsideration of this order under ORS 756.561. A request for rehearing or reconsideration must be filed with the Commission within 60 days of the date of service of this order. The request must comply with the requirements in OAR 860-001-0720. A copy of the request must also be served on each party to the proceedings as provided in OAR 860-001-0180(2). A party may appeal this order by filing a petition for review with the Court of Appeals in compliance with ORS 183.480 through 183.484.
