STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

I recommend that the Commission allow Portland General Electric (PGE) Company's Advice No. 2013-S5 to go into effect, with less than statutory notice, for meter readings on or after September 1, 2013.

DISCUSSION:

The contract with Upper Columbia Mill (UCM) provides for steam deliveries from PGE's Coyote Springs plant. The current contract was put into place in 2008, with an amendment reducing the amount of delivered steam allowed into effect in May 2013. The contract is due to expire at the end of August 2013. Both parties to the contract have signed the amendment extending the current contract through November 30, 2013 while they negotiate a new contract.

The contract amendment included as part of this advice filing does not change any terms of the contract except the end date. Therefore the contract continues to satisfy the original four requirements of the steam contract:

- The revenue from the steam sales covers relevant costs,
- The contract is not discriminatory,
- PGE customers will be held harmless, and
- The contract incorporates opportunity-cost pricing where steam sales

pricing is based on the market value of power that would otherwise be produced.

The Company has requested that the amended contract go into effect with meter readings on or before September 1, 2013. To allow this request requires a Commission waiver of OAR 860-022-0032¹.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that the Commission allow PGE Advice No. 2013-S5 to go into effect for meter readings on or after September 1, 2013.

PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:

The Commission waive OAR 860-022-0032 and allow PGE's Advice No. 2013-S5 to go into effect for meter readings on or after September 1, 2013.

¹ OAR 860-022-0032: "An energy or large telecommunications utility shall make all tariff changes applicable with service rendered on and after the effective date of the changes, unless the Commission by order provides otherwise."
