ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On March 1, 2007, Globalcom, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 07-074.


In a letter dated August 7, 2013, Patrick D. Crocker, Attorney for First Communications, LLC (FCL) and Globalcom, Inc. d/b/a First Communications of Illinois (Globalcom), notified the Commission of consummation of a *pro forma* merger of Globalcom into FCL. FCL holds an active certificate of authority to provide local and long distance telecommunications services in Oregon. See Docket CP 1345, Order No. 07-014. The letter also requested cancellation of Globalcom's certificate of authority. Globalcom is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2013, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Globalcom, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Globalcom, Inc. is canceled.
