DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED IN PART

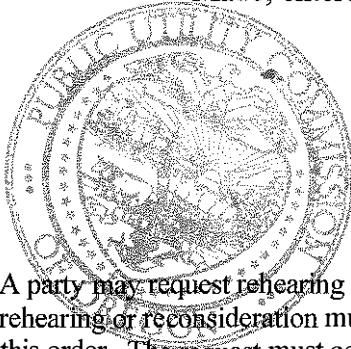
On July 28, 2005, BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. (BSLD) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 05-883.


In a letter dated November 15, 2013, David Collier, Area Manager, Regulatory, AT&T, requested that BSLD's certificate of authority be amended to reflect that BSLD will only be a provider of interexchange service in Oregon. The letter noted that BSLD is relinquishing its authority to provide intraexchange service, and has no customers receiving such services.

In view of the foregoing, BSLD's authority to provide intraexchange switched (local dial tone) and non-switched, private line (dedicated transmission) service in Oregon within all exchanges of the telecommunications utilities listed in Appendix A to Order No. 05-883 should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority held by BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. to provide intraexchange switched (local dial tone) and non-switched, private line (dedicated transmission) service is canceled, and their authority to provide interexchange service is retained.
