
ORDER

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION GRANTED

On January 9, 2014, the Commission issued Order No. 14-013, in which we directed Idaho Power Company to enter into a standard power purchase agreement to purchase the electrical output of the qualifying facility of Kootenai Electric Cooperative, Inc. On January 15, 2013, Idaho Power filed a Motion for Clarification, requesting that we clarify the appropriate avoided cost price to be paid to Kootenai. Idaho Power states that the applicable avoided cost price should be the avoided cost price in effect on the date we issued Order No. 14-013. Kootenai takes the position that the Commission's order granting Kootenai's complaint requires Idaho Power to purchase Kootenai's QF output at the avoided cost prices in effect on January 2, 2012, the date Kootenai filed its complaint.

We concur with Kootenai that, in granting Kootenai's complaint, we granted the claim for relief providing that Kootenai receive a Schedule 85 PPA with the rates that were in effect on the date that the complaint was filed. We direct Idaho Power to provide a standard contract with the avoided cost prices in effect on the date Kootenai's complaint was filed.
