ORDER NO. 14-058 CORRECTED NUNC PRO TUNC

On February 24, 2014 we issued Order No. 14-058, requiring electric utilities to make filings in compliance with the resolutions made in the order. The ordering paragraphs on page 32 of Order No. 14-058 are revised to read as follows:

- 1. The Issues List adopted by ALJ ruling on October 25, 2012 is re-adopted and attached to this Order as Appendix A.
- 2. Within sixty days of the date of this order, each electric utility shall file by application, and serve upon all parties to these proceedings, revised standard contract forms that set forth standard prices, terms and conditions that are consistent with the resolutions made in this order.
- 3. The revised standard contract forms shall become effective 30 days after the date of filing, unless otherwise suspended by the Oregon Public Utility Commission. Prior to the effective date, the standard contract forms shall be considered initial offers.
- 4. Within sixty days of the date of this order, each electric utility shall also file revised avoided cost prices that implement the resolutions made in this order.
- 5. On May 1 of each subsequent year, each electric utility shall file an update to avoided cost prices consistent with the resolutions made in this order.
- 6. A subsequent phase of these proceedings will be opened to address Phase II issues.

The remainder of Order No. 14-058 is unchanged. The order was entered on February 24, 2014; that remains the relevant date for calculating the due date for filing revised standard contract forms and avoided cost prices.
