DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

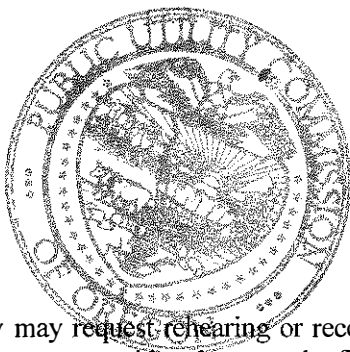
On April 24, 2014, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion to extend the due date for its Critical Peak Pricing (CPP) pilot report to June 1, 2014. PGE states that a primary component of the report is a third-party evaluation of the CPP program and that the third party requires additional time to complete its evaluation.


PGE's motion is granted. The time requirements established for the CPP report in Order No. 09-395 is modified to allow PGE to make the filing by June 1, 2014.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Portland General Electric Company's motion for an extension of time to file its CPP pilot report is granted. Portland General Electric Company must file its CPP pilot report by June 1, 2014.
