**DISPOSITION: DOCKETING ENTRY CLARIFIED; PRECAUTIONARY  
MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION DENIED**


On May 1, 2015, the Sunriver Owners Association (SROA) filed a "Precautionary Motion for Reconsideration" in this docket. SROA explains that its filing relates to an entry made to the Commission's online eDocket system. That entry, made on March 6, 2015, notes that Sunriver Water LLC filed an application for approval of an affiliated interest agreement. The eDocket entry referred to the filing as "Compliance" and directed the reader to docket UI 355 to view the application. To the extent that the "Compliance" action constitutes an order, SROA requests reconsideration because it does not believe the UI 355 application complies with the final order issued in this docket.

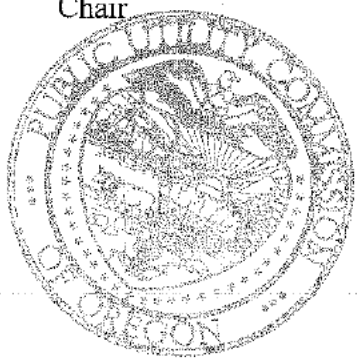
The "Compliance" action is simply a docketing entry intended to describe the type of filing. Like the docketing entry describing SROA's request here as "Motion," the "Compliance" action is ministerial in nature and does not constitute any decision by the Commission. The Commission has made no determination as to whether Sunriver Water has complied with the final order in this docket.


Accordingly, SROA's precautionary motion should be denied.
