## DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On February 19, 1997, BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. (BellSouth) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 97-066.

In a letter dated July 13, 2015, David Collier, AT&T Area Manager – Regulatory, requested that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon effective July 31, 2015, as BellSouth is ceasing provision of all services and no longer has any Oregon customers. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2015, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. is canceled, effective July 31, 2015.
