DISPOSITION: ADVICE FILING WITHDRAWN; DOCKET CLOSED

On April 3, 2015, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed tariff sheets in Advice No. 15-09 (docket ADV 21) to be effective May 20, 2015. The filing clarifies Rule C, Customer Attachment to Facilities, regarding relocation of facilities and when the requester will pay some or all of the costs.

By Order No. 15-227, we suspended PGE's Advice No. 15-09 for further investigation. Following informal discussions with the parties, PGE filed, on February 24, 2016, a letter withdrawing Advice No. 15-09 in its entirety.

PGE states that it may submit a new filing (under a new advice number) pending the outcome of an ongoing Court of Appeals case. PGE explains the court's decision may clarify when a developer is treated as an agent of the city for the purpose of developer-driven relocations. PGE notes this could inform the tariff language for Rule C, Customer Attachment to Facilities.
