ORDER

DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On June 20, 2013, TNCI Operating Company, LLC (TNCI) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 13-234.

In a letter dated July 25, 2016, Thomas M. Forte, Consultant to TNCI and Matrix Telecom, LLC (Matrix), requested the Commission cancel TNCI's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon. TNCI's customers were transferred to Matrix, and TNCI has ceased operations in Oregon. TNCI is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2016, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by TNCI Operating Company, LLC should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by TNCI Operating Company, LLC is canceled.

A request for rehearing or reconsideration must be filed with the Commission within 60 days of the date of service of this order. The request must comply with the requirements in OAR 860-001-0720.
