The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2016, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Impact Telecom, Inc. should be canceled.
