Finnigan, Attorney for CoastCom, Inc., requested that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it recently sold substantially all of its assets and related business operations to Astound Broadband, LLC. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2016, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by CoastCom, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by CoastCom, Inc. is canceled.
