DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On January 8, 2002, Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 02-014.

In a letter dated November 30, 2016, Shala Tazdani, CFO of Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc., requested that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it does not serve any customers or have any active telecommunications operations in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2016, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc. should be canceled.
